

Paper crafts: tulip

Are you ready to make your own origami tulip? Cut out the square along its dotted line and colour it. Then follow the instructions given below to make a tulip flower. You can roll a small strip of paper to make it's stalk and stick it along with the flower in your scrap book.











1. Fold into half in the dark line.

2. Fold the corner along the dark line.

3. Do the same for the other corner.

4. Fold down along the dark line.

Tulip flower is ready!





Paper crafts: make a dog face

Bheem and his friends were interested in craft work. Do you like to make something interesting on your own? Cut square along the dotted line, colour and fold to make the face of a dog along with them. The instructions are given below.



1. Fold a square piece of paper in half.



at the center and at the sides.



3. Fold along the 2. Make creases right dotted line and repeat for the left side.



4. Fold the lower tip up.



5. Draw the eye and mouth outlines



black. Dog face is ready!





Paper crafts: fish

Cut the square along the dotted lines, colour and fold to make a fish. Follow the stepwise instructions below. Enjoy!!



1. Fold both sides of the paper diagonally. In one half, make a crease and unfold.



3. Hold the paper as indicated and fold to the center forming a triangle.



4. Hold the right bottom corner of the triangle.



5. Fold it towards the center along the crease.



6. Do the same with the other corners.



8. Origami fish is ready!
