6. Their sense of hearing helps them to find the location of their prey.



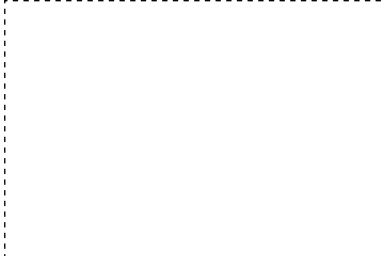

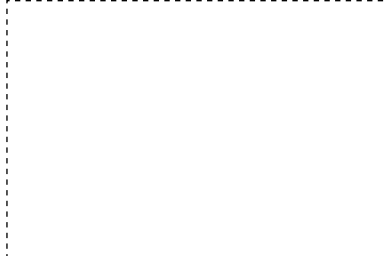
1. Inland Taipan



It contains the world's most toxic venom and is found in Australia.



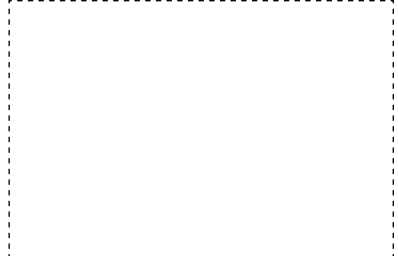
2. Boomslang



It is a beautiful green-colored venomous snake that is found in Africa.



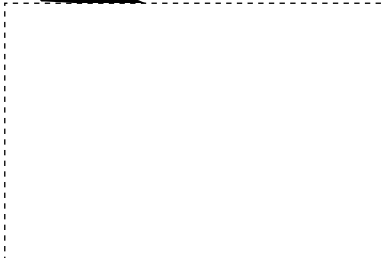
3. King Cobra



Longest venomous snake. It is abundantly found in India and all over Asia.



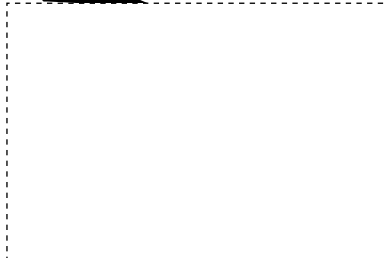
4. Black Tiger Snake



It behaves and looks like a King Cobra and is found in Australia.



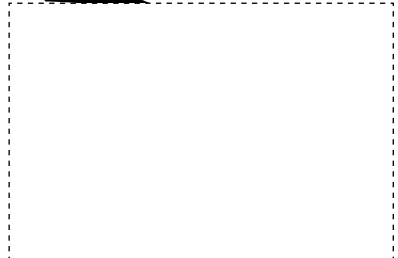
5. Black Mamba
