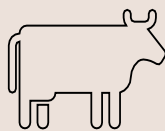
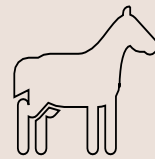

Egypt : Trees



As Egypt has a dry desert climate, we do not find a wide range of natural forests. The native plants are usually leafless, thorny and slender. The native species of the trees include acacia, palm, date palm, tamarisk, cactus, bamboo and about 100 types of grasses. Also there are some aromatic herbs and succulents that are found often. The coastal area has some rich variety of plants in spring. Here we have listed some trees and plants that are found in Egypt. 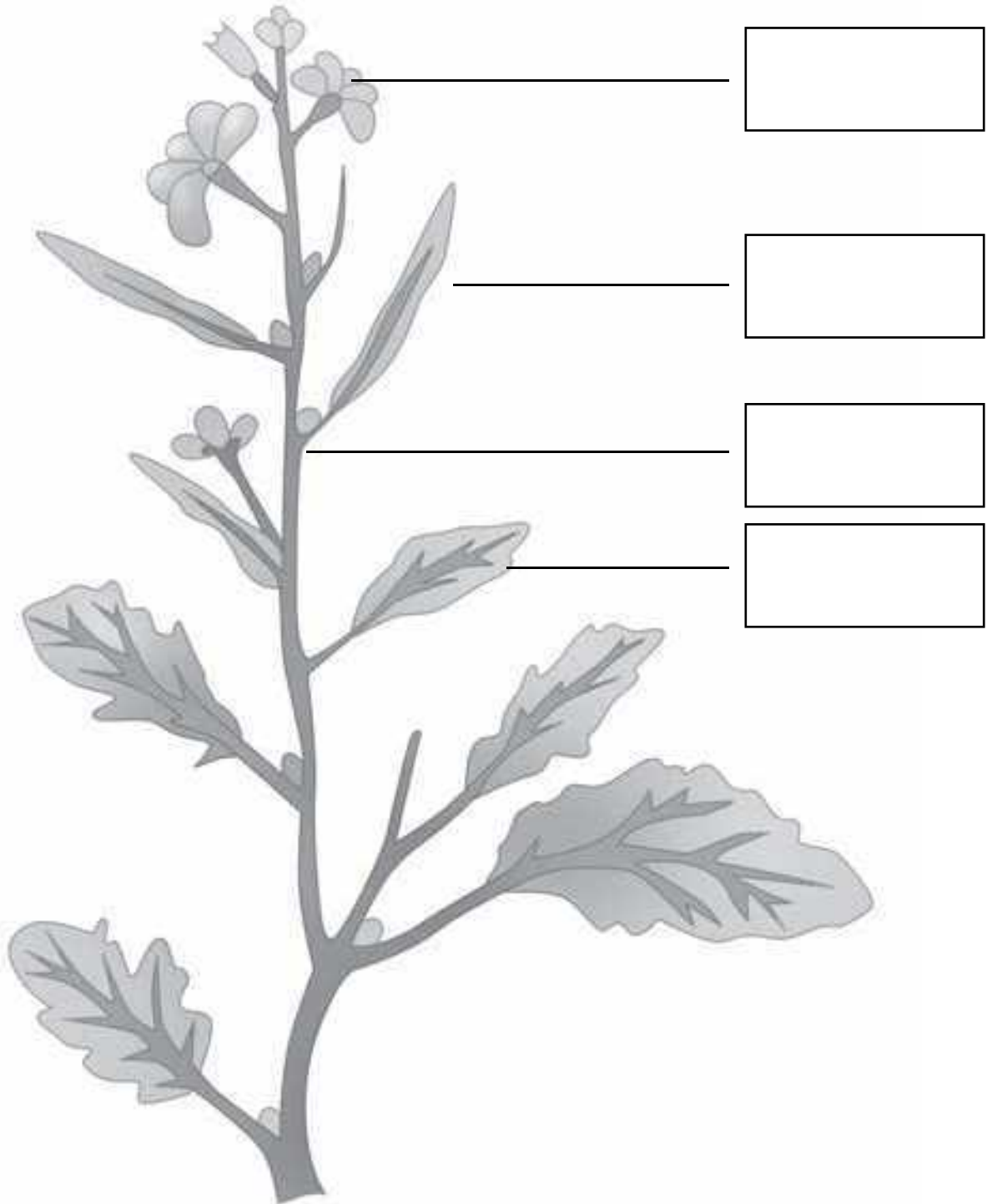
