

Answer

Did you know? Stomach rumbling can happen at any time, not just when you are hungry.

Borborygmi, or stomach rumblings, are the result of peristalsis in the stomach and small intestines — that is, they are due to normal digestion as food, fluid and gases pass through your gastrointestinal tract. When the tract is empty, however, borborygmi are louder because there is nothing in there to muffle the sound.
