Israel: National flag



The national flag of Israel has a white background (field) with two horizontal blue stripes across the top and the bottom. At the center of the flag is a blue Star of David. The Star of David represents the religion of Judaism and the stripes represent the stripes on a Jewish prayer shawl called a tallit. The flag was first displayed by Rison-leZion in 1885. Five months later after the establishment of the State of Israel, on 28 October 1948 the flag was adopted as national flag of Israel. Israel: Currency



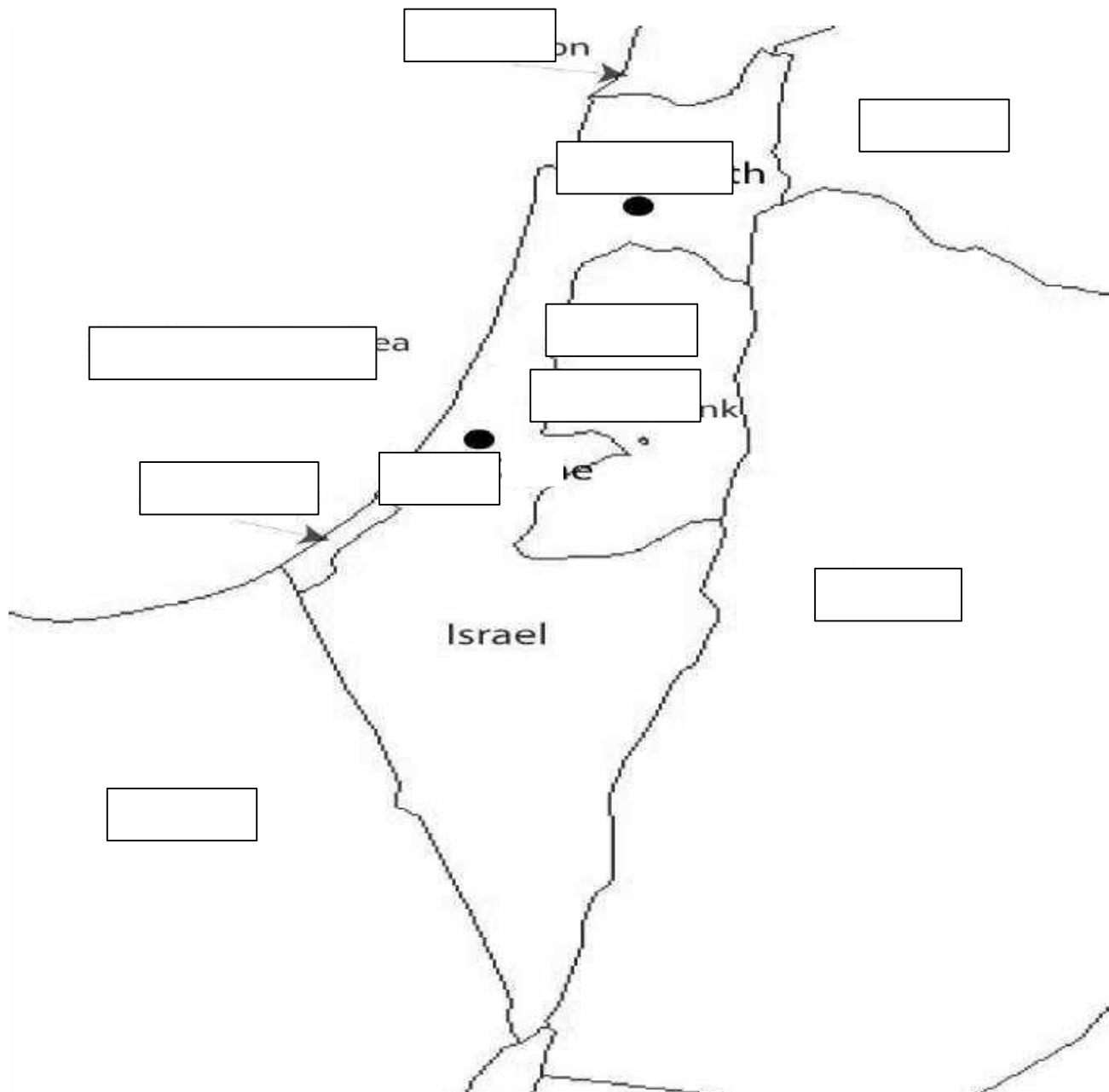
