Poetry: Types of poetry

Couplets	Poems where the first letter of each line spell out a word or phrase.
Tongue Twisters	A type of poetry from Japan. Three lines, with five, seven, five syllable structure.
Narrative Poems	Poems with five lines, usually are very funny.
Acrostic	Poems that have two lines of the same length and rhythm.
Riddles	Poems that are difficult to say fast.
Limerick	Poems which tell a story.
