# Poetry: Types of poetry

Couplets

Poems where the first letter of each line spells out a word or phrase.

Tongue Twisters

A type of poetry from Japan. Three lines, with a five, seven, five syllable structure.

Narrative Poems

Poems with five lines, usually are very funny.

Acrostic

Poems that have two lines of the same length and rhythm.

Riddles

Poems that are difficult to say fast.

Limerick

Poems which tell a story.

Haiku

Poems that use clues to help you solve a puzzle.
