# Money: Design your money



Making play money is pretty easy and fun. Let us make rupee notes of different denominations. You will need A4 size sheets, scissors and a black marker.


Steps 1 Cut the size of the notes as you want. The standard shape of a regular rupee note is a rectangle.

Steps 2 Cut them smaller, larger, or even another shape such as a triangle or square if you desire. You can also cut and use the template given below.

Step 3 Make sure that the note value is clear to read.

Step 4 It's up to you to use one or both sides of the note. A regular rupee note uses both sides.

Step 5 Use your creativity to colour and design the note.

# Spend, save and share: Money jars




