Collecting Stones: Five Stones Game

Five stones is a fun, simple game that you can play alone or with friends. All you need to play are 5 small items, traditionally stones. The object of the game is to complete a series of moves without dropping any of the stones. This game helps us improve our hand - eye - co-ordination and focus.

Game Steps:

- 1. Collect 5 small stones (pebbles) from your surrounding.
- 2. Wash them clean and Wipe them dry. (If you don't have 5 stones, you can use any small item for game pieces. You might try jacks, beads, marbles, or folded paper.)
- 3. Roll them in your hands and spread it on the floor as near as possible.
- 4. Play these different levels and mark one for every time you were able to catch the rock in the scoreboard.
- 5. In the end, total your score and enjoy your victory!

Level One: Pick one stone toss in the air and catch it. One by one, repeat it for all the five stones.


Level Two: Pick one stone toss in the air, pull second stone with the other hand and catch the first one with the dominant hand. Keep reperating this for all the stones.

Collecting Stones: Story Stones

Let's create a story with stones. Take some stones and paint them with pictures you like and tell the story to your friends and family using these stones .

Example of a stone story:

On a Sunny Sunday Morning came up the Sun Shining Bright (use the sun stone). It shined so bright that due to it's the water evaporated on Monday, turned into vapours on Tuesday and formed a cloud on Wednesday. This cloud went to meet the sun on Thursday but due to its heat the cloud melted and poured down on the earth as rains on Friday (Use the Sun & Cloud stone). These rains cooled the heat and helped the snow shower on Saturday (Use the snow stone). After it rained and snowed, popped up the sun on the sunny sunday morning with their friend rainbow and they all together made the weather beautiful. All the children laughed and played and thanked God (bring up the sun and rainbow stones first and show all of them together and smile).















Collecting Stones: stone craft

Let's make a paperweight to help your dad or mom organise their paper work.

Stationery Required: A small, smooth rock to hold some papers, colours of your choice.

Instructions:

- 1. Take a smooth rock from your garden, neighbourhood.
- 2. Wash it clean.
- 3. Wipe it dry.
- 4. Now paint with the colour of your choice. Let it dry if watercoloured.
- 5. Write or paint "My dad rocks!" or "My mom rocks!" with a dark / contrast colour & gift it to your dad or mom.
